Asbestos abatement activities will be conducted at Redding Elementary School from July 19 through August 9, 2010. These activities involve the removal of the following materials:

Custodial Closet	Floor Tile & Associated Mastic	60 Square Feet

The locations of these materials are depicted on the orientation sketch on the following page.

Portions of Redding Elementary School will be occupied by persons under 18 years of age while the asbestos abatement work is underway. The following precautions have been implemented to make sure that these occupants are not exposed to asbestos as a result of this work:

- **Independent Asbestos Consultant:** Redding Public Schools has retained an independent, Connecticut-licensed asbestos consultant to represent the school's interests. This consultant designed the abatement project and will monitor the abatement contractor's work to assure compliance with the specifications and applicable regulations.
- **Licensed Abatement Contractor:** The abatement will be performed by accredited asbestos abatement supervisors and workers employed by a Connecticut-licensed asbestos abatement contractor
- **Physical Security:** The asbestos abatement work areas will be physically separated from the occupied areas of the school by locked doors or temporary hard barriers.
- **DPH Approval:** The Connecticut Department of Public Health will review and approve our plans and procedures for conducting this work while the building is occupied.
