### **Instruction - General**

The Board of Education believes the instructional program of the public schools to be its highest priority, and it is therefore important for the Board and the professional staff to work cooperatively in determining educational goals and objectives which meet the needs of students.

Within limitations of budgets made available to it by the town, the Board of Education will provide personnel, equipment, instructional supplies and materials, and other support required to meet professional staff, student and community needs. The Board, understanding that education requires continuing change, also supports continuing in-service education for certified and non-certified staff.
