Pledge of Allegiance

The district shall provide time each school day for students to recite the Pledge of Allegiance. Such recitation is voluntary. If a student has made the personal decision to not recite the Pledge of Allegiance, such student may remain seated or standing. Students may wish to use this time for silent meditation. All students must be courteous and respectful of the beliefs of others and are expected to maintain order and decorum appropriate to the school environment.
