Bus Conduct

School transportation privileges are extended to students based on their satisfactory behavior on the bus.

Students will be advised that they may be suspended from school and/or transportation services for unsatisfactory conduct while awaiting or receiving transportation to and from school which endangers persons or property or violates a Board policy or administrative regulation.
